

Privacy Policy

Midwest Family Broadcasting's privacy statement has been created to protect your privacy. We are committed to keep all customers' information confidential and secure. This policy administers the manner in which Midwest Family Broadcasting uses and maintains information collected from its customers.

Information we collect

Midwest Family Broadcasting collects personal information when you register with www.q1021.fm, www.1047thecave.com, www.star929.fm or www.1051bob.fm or when you order products or services. Midwest Family Broadcasting will collect and keep information, such as:

- Your name
- E-mail address
- Postal Address
- Telephone numbers
- Credit card information
- IP addresses

How secure is the information we collect?

At Midwest Family Broadcasting we are extremely serious about security in order to protect your confidential information. Midwest Family Broadcasting uses Secure Socket Layers (SSL) encryption when transmitting data on www.q1021.fm, www.1047thecave.com, www.star929.fm or www.1051bob.fm Shopping Carts. During all transactions, an icon resembling a padlock is displayed on the bottom of most browsers during SSL transactions. All financial information is encrypted, and our company databases are accessible only to internal employees. Our station databases are secured behind 3 types of firewall and stored on an offsite database. Our company databases are accessible only to internal employees.

Cookies

What is a cookie? A cookie is a piece of information sent by a Web server to a user's browser. (A Web server is the computer that "hosts" a Web site, and responds to requests from a user's browser.) Cookies may include information such as login or registration identification, user preferences, online "shopping cart" information, etc. The browser saves the information, and sends it back to the Web server whenever the browser returns to the Web site. Midwest Family Broadcasting uses cookies to keep track of user's preferences while the user is visiting the website. Cookies also help minimize load times and save on server processing. Midwest Family Broadcasting may use cookies that store your information such as your password being remember or not and other information.

Sharing and Disclosure

Occasionally Midwest Family Broadcasting may send our customers information about our company and get in touch with you when necessary. Midwest Family Broadcasting will not otherwise disclose its customer's personal information and account information unless Midwest Family Broadcasting has reason to believe that disclosing such information is necessary to identify, make contact with, or bring legal action against someone who may be causing harm or interfering with the rights or property of Midwest Family Broadcasting, Midwest Family Broadcasting's customers or others. Midwest Family Broadcasting will never disclose personal information to third parties.

Customer Responsibilities

You are responsible for the security of your login and passwords. Make sure you keep them in a safe place and do not share them with others. Always remember to logout after your session ends to ensure that other people cannot access your account information.
